James Frankovic has served for the past seven years with CMG where he has brought a wealth of knowledge and hands-on experience in Defense acquisition, specifically the use of Other Transaction Authority to rapidly develop critical technologies, gained from his long and distinguished Army civilian career. Mr. Frankovic is responsible for building CMG's consortium portfolio, which now includes the Consortium for Energy, Environment and Demilitarization (CEED); the Consortium for Command, Control and Communications in Cyberspace (C5); and the Naval Aviation Systems Consortium (NASC). In addition, he manages the multiple Other Transaction Agreements between these consortia and the Government and oversees nearly \$1.5B in active projects.

Mr. Frankovic provides policy analysis and subject-matter support to DoD leadership and Members of Congress concerning a broad range of acquisition-reform initiatives – all aimed at accelerating innovation and providing new capabilities to the Warfighter.
