

ERDCWERX Request for Proposal – Website Development

ERDCWERX is an innovation hub of DEFENSEWERX, based in Vicksburg, Mississippi, that actively supports innovation and collaboration goals of its government partner, the U.S. Army Engineer Research and Development Center (ERDC). ERDCWERX operates under a Partnership Intermediary Agreement (PIA) with ERDC that facilitates direct support for ERDC technology transfer and transition.

ERDCWERX seeks to expand its web presence to promote additional ERDC capabilities. This RFP invites proposals for the design, development and occasional maintenance of a new website that increases awareness and engagement of prospective government and industry customers of ERDC field offices and laboratory testing/demonstration services. The website will effectively communicate the value of these resources and promote collaboration opportunities. It should also provide a clear and user-friendly process for interested parties to express interest and pursue access to these services offered by or at ERDC.

A key focus of the website will be to contain content similar to that currently piloted on ERDCWERX.org (www.erdcwerx.org/cbitec/) regarding ERDC's Contingency Basing Integration Training & Evaluation Center (CBITEC) in Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. While the initial structure of the website should accommodate this content regarding CBITEC, it must be designed with scalability in mind—allowing for the future inclusion of additional ERDC field offices, services, and capabilities.

ERDCWERX currently maintains two websites—**ERDCWERX.org** and **ERDCinnovation.org**. The new site may be modeled after some of the preferred structure/elements of these sites. Additionally, it should complement and align with the branding and messaging of the two existing platforms.

ERDCWERX will retain exclusive ownership of all rights to the completed website, including but not limited to its design, content, source code, and all associated intellectual property. In addition, ERDCWERX will be granted full administrative access to the website's backend and content management systems, ensuring the ability to make updates, manage content, and oversee all technical aspects without restriction.

Scope of Work

The selected subcontractor will be responsible for the full lifecycle of website design and development including planning, implementation, testing, and deployment. The anticipated scope of work includes, but is not limited to the following:

• Website Strategy, Planning, and Information Gathering

- Collaborate with ERDCWERX to define site architecture and user experience goals
- Develop a scalable website framework that contains initial content regarding CBITEC and other featured field offices and services while allowing for future expansion to include additional ERDC field offices and services

• Design & User Experience

- Create wireframes and design mockups that reflect ERDCWERX branding and messaging
- Ensure intuitive navigation and a visually engaging interface tailored to the target audience
- Incorporate responsive design for optimal performance across devices

Development

- Build the website using WordPress and support maintenance capability by the ERDCWERX marketing and communications team
- Customize themes and plugins as needed to meet functional and design requirements
- Implement features such as informational pages; media galleries; interactive database forms for expressing interest and requesting access to services; search functionality

• Accessibility & Optimization

- o Ensure compliance with accessibility standards (e.g., WCAG 2.1)
- Optimize for search engines (SEO) and fast load times

• Testing & Quality Assurance

- Conduct thorough testing across browsers and devices
- Address bugs and usability issues prior to launch

• Launch & Support

- Assist with expedient development, deployment and launch of website
- o Provide initial orientation/recommendations for site maintenance
- Offer support following website launch
- Deliver documentation for future updates and scalability

- Familiarity with accessibility standards (e.g., WCAG 2.1) and SEO best practices
- Ability to create scalable website structures that accommodate future expansion
- Experience implementing interactive features such as forms, media galleries, and search functionality
- Strong project management skills and ability to meet deadlines
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills
- Availability to provide training and post-launch support

Project Timeframe & Anticipated Steps

ERDCWERX seeks a subcontractor to design, develop and deliver a new website according to the project timeframe and anticipated steps:

- August 27, 2025 Deadline for proposal submission
- September 3, 2025 Notify top candidates, request additional detail if needed
- September 8-12, 2025 Conduct phone interviews with top candidates if needed
- September 15, 2025 Select preferred candidate, initiate negotiations
- September 19, 2025 Complete negotiations and finalize vendor agreement
- September 24, 2025 Vendor commences work
- November 17-21, 2025 Vendor completes final beta version of website
- December 8-12, 2025 Vendor completes website launch
- January-September 2026 Post-launch support of website, upon request

Assuming successful delivery of services, ERDCWERX reserves the right to extend, as needed, the initial agreement timeframe and funding to support future enhancements or additional phases of work. ERDCWERX will take responsibility for marketing/generating website traffic.
